


Congratulations

- "Enjoying seeing what has changed around the school"






Wellbeing




Virtual Assembly

Learning Conferences THURSDAY 25TH JUNE 2020 FROM 3.30PM-8.00PM & FRIDAY 26TH JUNE FROM 8.30AM – 1.00PM

Dear Parents.

Learning Conferences will be conducted on THURSDAY 25^{TH} JUNE 2020 FROM 3.30PM-8.00PM & FRIDAY 26^{TH} JUNE FROM 8.30AM - 1.00PM

The objective of these meetings is for you to share information about your child to help establish a team where we work together to support your child's learning. These meetings supported by pre-assessments will help to inform your child's learning goals.

The interviews will be in 15 minute time slots (10 min interview with 5mins to log off and log onto the next meeting). Once all parents have registered your classroom teacher will send a link for you to use on the day.

Interviews will be of 10min duration.

Using this system you will be able to book the interview times that suit you best from any internet-connected computer. A computer will be available in the meeting room allocated in the office area during school hours if you do not have internet access at home or elsewhere.

Please access the system as follows:


- Go to the school's home page www.sbedesbn.catholic.edu.au
- Click News/Events scroll down to the Parent Teacher Online then click on



• You will see "Obtain PIN/Password" on the login screen. Enter your email address and PTO will then send an email to the address containing the login details for the parent(s) with that email address.

Full instructions are provided to you after log in. Please note the following points:

- When you log on, the system displays only your own child/children. Bookings are made for
 parents/guardians. Couples can however log on to the system simultaneously to coordinate bookings.
 If two parents/guardians wish to attend a single interview timeslot, one parent/guardian should make
 the booking then both can attend.
- You will only see time slots which are *available* at the time you are using the system. As time slots are booked for teachers, those timeslots are no longer displayed as available. PTO prevents double-booking of teachers or parents/guardians.
- When you have made all the bookings you require, you can print a *report* of your bookings in time order.
- PTO bookings are open and close on MONDAY 15TH JUNE @ 7.00am.
- If you see this symbol displayed along side the class name, it means this teacher recommends that you book an interview.
- Other parents may be making bookings at the same time that you are using the system. It is possible, though unlikely, that a timeslot is displayed to you as available, but is then booked by another parent shortly afterwards. If you then attempt to book this time slot it will not be available and a message will be displayed to indicate this.
