


Thank you to those parents who sent photos in last week. Please send any photos to the office so that we can include them in upcoming newsletters.

I would like to thank all the families who have finalised their school fee payments for Term 1 in the past two weeks and to those who have finalised 2020 completely.



During this time of remote learning the staff are constantly looking at ways we can continue the normality of school life. Our PE department have proposed the following; a virtual cross country as cross country was take place this term. Richard and Jenny have proposed the following. I remind everyone to still keep all the social distancing requirements etc that the government has put into place.

In term 2 we would have been holding our House Cross Country this week (and hopefully we still will be able to when we are back to school and can be together) but in the meantime. . .

We are still going to run our House cross country but do it individually on Thursday 7th May.

You can do it at ANYTIME during the day at a venue that you can get to with a parent. Macleay Park, Myrtle, Victoria Park, Gordon Barnard etc (most ovals are around 400 metres around the inside of the fence) or go somewhere where you know the rough distance you need to run. For those that know the school cross country route you might like to go and run your laps there.

Your group age and distance you need to run is according to what age you are turning this year:


Prep to Year 2 run 1km,

- 8, 9 and 10 year olds run 2km,
- 11, 12 and 13 year olds run 3km

Once you have completed your run/walk, then enter your details into the google form by 6pm (parents you might need to assist) to have your run included in the Remote House Cross Country tally.

To be included in the count you must upload a photo of yourself competing in House Cross Country (hopefully the photo is of you running in your house colours) on Seesaw or preferably attached to the google form (maybe do both)

We will make a short 2020 Collage or video to share of cross country COVID 19 style.
